## Betty: Living with asthma pre-NHS



### Living with asthma pre-NHS

- ▶ Born 1919
- Severe life-threatening asthma throughout childhood
- Lost school time, job restraints, life restrictions
- Cause unknown
- ▶ No effective treatments, no NHS care
- Emile Coué: 'optimistic auto-suggestion'
- ► Fowler's solution: contained potassium arsenite, tincture of digitalis, sodium phenobarbital, potassium iodide

#### The impact of NHS research on Betty's life

- ▶ 1960s: definitively proved animal dander causes asthma
- ▶ 1970s: inhaled steroids for asthma

- Avoidance of asthma triggers
- > Safe, effective treatment, few side-effects
- > Betty had no full-blown asthma attacks ever again
- > Excellent NHS care for the consequences of arsenic treatment



#### Growing up with the NHS

- Childhood impact of asthma and its treatment
- Stigma self and family
- Impact of Ventolin inhaler
- Research clinic: first clinical trial of inhaled steroids for asthma: Harry Morrow Brown
- Value of primary care-led NHS care: GP, pharmacy
- ► Impact: confidence to self-manage, no hospital admissions







#### NHS asthma care today

- Impact of asthma
- Primary care: asthma-interested GP
- First clinical trial of Montelukast aged 9
- Adult care: value of hospital asthma service with direct access to specialist – avoiding prolonged hospital admissions
- Now Mepolizumab (humanized monoclonal antibody)





#### NHS Research: our hopes looking forward

- ► Patient and public involvement gives us opportunities to influence research and NHS clinical care
- Partnership with patients to identify research relevant to our needs
- ► And personalised care that meets our individual needs
